This is blunt at first, with a rose-petal scent that belies its initially powerful stance. Forget it in a decanter for an hour or two, and when you come back to it, you'll find the volcanic soils more clearly expressed in the wine's tannins, as they shape and detail the heady, rich black-cherry fruit. A potent blend of cabernet sauvignon, merlot and cabernet franc, this needs five or years more in the cellar to show its best. (W&S 8/19; 310 cases)
